

**ORDINANCE NO. 729**

**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING THE MADRAS POLICE DEPARTMENT AUTHORITY TO ADOPT POLICY CREATING AND IMPOSING IMPOUNDING CONDITIONS FOR IMPOUNDED VEHICLES AND INVENTORY PROCEDURE OF IMPOUNDED VEHICLES, REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 550 AND 666, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

The City of Madras ordains as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The City Police of the City of Madras shall adopt a department policy creating and imposing impounding conditions for impounded vehicles and for the inventory of impounded vehicles subject to approval by the City of Madras.

**SECTION 2:** Ordinances #550 and #666 are hereby repealed. This repeal does not affect or invalidate any proceeding, action or assessment made under the terms of these ordinances.

**SECTION 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE.**

It is hereby determined and declared that existing conditions are such that it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, general welfare, and safety of the citizens of the City of Madras that an emergency be declared to exist; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor of the City of Madras.
