Canada or Perennial Goldenrod – Solidago canadensis

Common Groundsel – Senecio vulgaris
Quackgrass – Agropyron repens
Kochia – Kochia scoparia

C List –

Eradication not likely; Needs Control

Rattali Fescue – Vulpia myuros
Wild Oats – Avena fatua
Medusahead Rye – Taeniatherum caput – medusae
Common Purslane – Portulaca oleracea
Purple Mustard – Chorispora tenella
Common Mullein – Verbascum Thapsus
Hembit – Lamium amplexiculic
St. Johnswort – Hypericum perforatum
* **Yellow Sweetclover** – Metolius offimalis

KEY:

: = These two weeds are “A” rated weeds when found north of Madras on Hwy 97 and south of Madras, west of Hwy 26.

* = Yellow Sweetclover is only a noxious weed when on the road right-of-way.

** = Iris (Yellow Flag) is an “A” rated weed when north of Haystack Reservoir and Round Butte Dam.

*** = False-Brome & Ribbon Grass is an “A” rated weed outside an ornamental site.
