

ORDINANCE NO. 517

AN ORDINANCE PREVENTING PERSONS UNDER EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE FROM BEING UPON THE STREETS, ALLEYS, AND PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY OF MADRAS, AFTER CERTAIN HOURS.

The City of Madras ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: CURFEW RESTRICTIONS

No person under the age of eighteen years shall be permitted to loiter or play upon, or wander about the streets, alleys, or public places of the City of Madras between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. on school nights and 12:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. on non-school nights and holidays unless such child shall be accompanied by his or her parent or guardian.

SECTION 2: PENALTIES

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall, upon a plea of guilty or upon conviction thereof before the City Municipal Court Judge, be punished for the first offense by community service to be administered through the Jefferson County Juvenile Officer and for each succeeding offense by additional community service or a fine of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$200.00 and the cost of the action.

SECTION 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Whereas the conditions in the City of Madras are such that in the judgement of the Common Council an emergency exists, and it is necessary for the public peace, and morals of the City, and the inhabitants thereof, that this ordinance shall become operative and take effect from and after its passage, approval by the Mayor and publication, as required by law, which publication shall be by posting.

Passed by the Common Council of the City of Madras and approved by the Mayor on November 10, 1992.
