

ORDINANCE NO. 336**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE STATE GAMBLING LAWS, PROVIDING FOR SOCIAL GAME GAMBLING FOR CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS, REPEALING SECTIONS 4 AND 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. 32 OF THE CITY OF MADRAS, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY.****The city of Madras ordains as follows:**

Section 1. Adopting State Gambling Laws. That ORS 167.117, 167.121, 167.122 Section 1, 167.127 Section 1, 167.132 Section 1, 167.137 Section 1, 167.142, 167.147 Section 1, 167.153, 167.158, 167.162, are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2. [Social Games Prohibited; Exception.] Social games as defined in ORS 167.117 are totally prohibited in the city of Madras, except that private homes and charitable organizations as defined in ORS 167.117, Section (3) (c) may engage in social games where no house player, house banker, house odds exist and there is no house income from the operation of the social games.

Section 3. [Repeal.] Sections 4 and 5 of Ordinance No. 32 of the city of Madras are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Penalties. A person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by imprisonment for a period not to exceed 90 days, or by a fine not to exceed \$300.00 or by both.
